There must also be one observer for each skier or tube being towed, and any motorized boat must have an audible alarm and a fire extinguisher.

A Reminder: During the past few weeks we have lost our electricity twice on Lake Todd. Although it was repaired quickly, it's a good idea to have those candles handy!

Did you know . . .

All property owners on Lake Todd are part-owners of the dam. The cost of registration of the dam is \$300 per year, and several hundred dollars are needed each year to maintain a healthy dam and monitor water quality. We all share in these costs by paying our Lake Todd dues of \$25.00 per year. We all enjoy the benefits of the dam by having a beautiful and healthy lake.
